

## What is a PrintValet™?

The PrintValet, by PrinterOn®, is a convenient keypad with an LCD display that is designed to enhance the user experience of PrintSpots™ printing solutions. This functional keypad enables users to securely and privately release their print jobs without ever accessing a computer.



## How it's used

The PrintValet connects to a PC using a USB port and offers an intuitive user interface for the PrinterOn® mobile printing software. The PrintValet is ideal for the following situations:

The PC, with the mobile printing software installed, is secured where the user may not have access or permission to use it for print release;

A PC in a heavily used, busy location. The PrintValet allows immediate print release without waiting for the computer;

The PrintConnect network device is configured to run the mobile printing software.

## Installation Requirements

- An active PrintSpots printing service by PrinterOn.
- PrinterOn Print Delivery Station (PDS) software. (Minimum version 2.4 GB)
- Print Valet peripheral device.
- Print Valet software.
- Operating System:
  - Windows 2000, XP, Server 2003 or Vista.
- Hard disk space: 6MB.
- Memory: 64MB.
- An available USB port.

## Benefits

The PrintValet is a flexible, optional add-on that complements PrinterOn's existing solutions. This means you have a choice in selecting a solution that fits your specific need.

The PrintValet ensures utmost privacy and security. It will only accept a 4 - 10 digit secure release code that is randomly created by PrinterOn and sent to the user in an email.

PrintValet offers a reliable backup system. If the release code was entered incorrectly or cannot be recalled by the user, the operator can still identify and release the job. If the hardware fails, the software GUI is a functional standby.

## To release print jobs using the PrintValet.

1. At the first screen, press <OK>. To return to the first screen press <Cancel>.
2. At the ID code prompt, enter the release code that corresponds with the print job(s) you wish to print. Press <OK>.
3. PrintValet will search for your print job. The number of jobs that match the entered release code and the total number of pages that will be printed is displayed
